### Excursion on 25<sup>th</sup> of June 2020

The June 25 excursion will be organized in different groups with different departures. Each group will have its own itinerary. The places visited will be the same for each group at different times of the day. They will all find themselves in a single meeting point to visit and free time.

### **Optional Excursions**

### 1. Rasiglia e Spoleto 22.06.2020 - € 30,00

The excursion n ° 1 will bring the participants to visit two characteristic localities of the territory such as Rasiglia called "the little Venice" and Spoleto a beautiful medieval village with the famous Ponte delle Torri.

A buffet will be included during the excursion.

### 2. Deruta e Spello – 23.06.2020 - € 50,00

The excursion n ° 2 will lead the participants to visit two characteristic localities of the territory such as Deruta famous for the realization of majolica and Spello a beautiful medieval village with a visit to the Villa Roman.

During the excursion lunch will be included.

### 3. Cascata delle Marmore – 23.06.2020 - € 60,00

The Cascata delle Marmore is a waterfall that is located about 7.5 km away from Terni, in Umbria, almost at the end of the Valnerina, the long valley carved by the Nera river. It is a waterfall with controlled flow, among the highest in Europe, being able to count on a total drop of 165 m, divided into three jumps, inserted in a large natural park. The name derives from the calcium carbonate salts present on the rocks that are similar to white marble.

During the excursion lunch will be included.

### 4. Pozzo di San Patrizio – 23.06.2020 - € 50,00

The historic San Patrizio well is a structure built by Antonio da Sangallo the Younger in Orvieto, between 1527 and 1537, at the behest of Pope Clement VII, fresh from the Sack of Rome and eager to protect himself in case of siege of the city in which he had retired. The work on the well - designed to supply water in the event of a disaster or siege - was completed during the papacy of Paolo III Farnese (1534-1549). Access to the well, a masterpiece of engineering, is guaranteed by two oneway helical ramps, completely autonomous and served by two different doors, which allowed them to transport the extracted water without obstructing it and without having to resort to the only that went up to the village from the valley floor. The well, 54 meters deep, [1] was built by digging in the tuff of the plateau on which Orvieto stands, a stone quite hard, but which is suffering, after several centuries, from the sewage discharges. It has a cylindrical shape with a circular base with a diameter of 13 m. The stairs are 248, and the large windows that give light to you are 70. Perhaps because of the aura of sacred and magic that accompanies deep cavities, or by pure imitation of cinematographic models, modern tourists throw coins in them hoping to return. The well took the name of St. Patrick, probably, because it was used as a place of explation of sins in the same way as a cave, existing in Ireland called "Purgatorio di San Patrizio". During the excursion lunch will be included.

### 5. Roma – guided tour by Bus – 23.06.2020 - € 80,00

A bus transfer from the rally center to Rome is planned.

In Rome the participants will get on the buses that will take them to visit the major monuments of Rome, they will have disposable earphones with which they will be explained the areas visited in different languages. It will be possible to get off the bus, as the buses make a continuous circular route throughout the day, to fully enjoy the beauties of Rome and then get back on the buses and return to the collection point at the established times to be shown at the rally center.
